The FHBSC and TSC Challenge to be held at TSC on the 29 and 30 November 2008 marks the 40th Anniversary of the Hobie 14. Calling all TSC hobie 14 and 16 sailors ... we need to increase our numbers and take up the Challenge.

The emphasis for this event is on fun sailing. This will include both round the cans racing and a long haul. The event is a "Team Challenge" between FHBSC and TSC.

Entrants will identify their boats (as either FHBSC or TSC) by means of a coloured ribbon.

### Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2008

Longhaul: Start not before 13h00

Then: Hull flying competition (weather permitting)

### Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2008

Round the cans: Start not before 11h00 (races will be back to back)

Last race on Sunday, start not later than 14h00

**Prize Giving:** Not less than 2 hours after the start of last race (Aiming to be not later than 16h00)

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup>, as well as fun prizes, & a **Floating Trophy** for the winning club.

## Rules:

The racing will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2005-2008, The Equipment Rules of Sailing (ERS) 2005 - 2008, the Class Rules of the Hobie Class, and the Sailing Instructions.

Note: During course racing: The last finishing yacht shall be not longer than 20 minutes after the first finishing yacht.

## Fees:

Entry just R25 + *any voluntary* contributions to the Hobie Worlds shortfall will be much appreciated and can be paid at Registration. ☺

**Safety:** All yachts and entrants shall comply with the TSC safety requirements at all times.
